

REMOVE ROOM

On occasions a pupil may need to be removed from a lesson. They will spend a period of their day working with Mrs. Pottinger, Miss. Clark or Mr. Abdullah. This will be for a short period until the relationship can be repaired with the member of staff.

CITY IN THE COMMUNITY

Specialised provision is available every Wednesday for a group of 15 Year 10 pupils for whom there have been ongoing concerns in KS3. Pupils work with coaches from MCFC and are following a 2 year accredited programme which seeks to re-engage pupils.

C2

This is a room where pupils who are being reintegrated from a fixed term exclusion and/or have demonstrated repeated breaches of the Compelling Behaviour Policy work on personal challenges and re-engagement with the school curriculum. Curriculum work is completed so pupils don't fall behind, as is community service.

WAVE 2 INTERVENTIONS

Some groups of pupils receive additional support through small groups led by Heads of Year. These groups explore the emotional needs and behaviours needed to be successful in school. They focus on resilience and character development. Sessions take place all year for a 6-8 week period. Pupils chosen for these are identified through discussion with Heads of Year and form tutors and receive approx. 1-2 hours a week.

WAVE 3 INTERVENTIONS

We have a team of 5 mentors who work alongside individual pupils and families who need highly specialised support for their emotional needs and to support their wellbeing and mental health. This is for a specified length of time and may come through identification in the Wave 2 process or at a specific point of crisis. There are two rooms available for these children to access: one a therapeutic, nurture and social area and another a small, quiet work room.

HEADS OF YEAR ARE THERE TO SUPPORT INDIVIDUAL CHILDREN AND FAMILIES. IN ADDITION DIRECTORS OF KEY STAGE THREE AND FOUR HELP SUPPORT THE LINK BETWEEN THE ACADEMIC AND PASTORAL

ALL PUPILS RECEIVE PASTORAL SUPPORT FROM FORM TUTORS. COMPELLING TUTOR TIME TAKES PLACE EVERY MORNING. THE TUTOR IS THE FIRST PORT OF CALL.
