

REFLECTION ROOM

On occasions a pupil may need to be removed from a lesson. They will spend a period of their day working with the Heads of Year. This will be for a short period until the relationship can be repaired with the member of staff or pupil.

CITY IN THE COMMUNITY

Specialised provision is available every Monday-Thursday for groups of Year 10 and Year 11 pupils for whom there have been ongoing concerns in KS3. Pupils work with coaches from MCFC and are following a 2 year accredited programme which seeks to re-engage pupils.

YOUTH SERVICE

The Youth Service work in school twice a week with groups of pupils or individuals whom have been identified as needing additional support. Mentoring and projects are used to work with pupils on personal challenges and re-engagement with the school curriculum. They also provide an Alternative Curriculum out of school for pupils at risk of becoming school refusers and those at risk of exclusion.

WAVE 2 INTERVENTIONS

Some groups of pupils receive additional support through small groups led by Heads of Year. These groups explore the emotional needs and behaviours needed to be successful in school. They focus on resilience and character development. Sessions take place all year for a 6-8 week period. Pupils chosen for these are identified through discussion with Heads of Year and form tutors and receive approx. 1-2 hours a week.

WAVE 3 INTERVENTIONS

We have a team of 6 mentors who work alongside individual pupils and families who need highly specialised support for their emotional needs and to support their wellbeing and mental health. This is for a specified length of time and may come through identification in the Wave 2 process or at a specific point of crisis. Mentors receive professional learning from two Educational Psychologists on a weekly basis to give them strategies and tools to support pupils.

HEADS OF YEAR SUPPORT INDIVIDUAL CHILDREN AND FAMILIES. IN ADDITION, DIRECTORS OF KEY STAGE THREE AND FOUR HELP SUPPORT THE LINK BETWEEN THE ACADEMIC AND PASTORAL
