<p>Key skills</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use tier 2 and tier 3 vocabulary effectively in expert books - Challenge and develop own values, beliefs and attitudes to prepare for adult life in a pluralistic and global community - Develop well-argued (PEEL) and balanced oral (using formal talk) and written responses (FARM) - Express own beliefs and ideas using a variety of forms of expression - Having challenging conversations in a safe, supported and thoughtful environment - Investigate the influence and impact of religion on individuals, communities and societies - Provide opportunities for considering and answering 'big questions' and ultimate questions - Provide opportunities to challenge misconceptions and negative stereotypes - Reflect on, respond to and evaluate own view and the beliefs/views of others in response to contemporary moral issues in an ever-changing world - Develop logical chains of reasoning
